Official Scholarship Entry Form

Introduction

The SASC Scholarship is open to any graduating senior attending the SASC Conference each year. Only one application per member school will be accepted. The scholarship is funded by contributions made by SASC member schools. The scholarship recipient will be selected by a committee, which will meet during the conference. The decision of the committee will be final.

Entrance Requirements

- Applicant must be a graduating senior delegate in attendance at the SASC Conference.
- Applicant must complete the SASC Official Scholarship Entry Form.
- Applicant must submit a transcript.
- Applicant must submit a TYPED statement describing what the scholarship means to him/her and how he/she plans to use it.
- A nominating adult (teacher, advisor, counselor, principal, employer, or adult youth group advisor) must submit a TYPED statement explaining why the applicant deserves the scholarship.
