Junior Division Public Speaking Contest: Grades 6-9
Official Entry Form

As a part of the SASC Comprehensive Awards Program, a Public Speaking Contest is held each year at the annual SASC Conference. All member schools in attendance at the conference are eligible to enter. Each school may enter one (1) student in the senior division (grades 10-12) and one (1) student in the junior division (grades 6-9). Students entering this competition cannot be workshop presenters for this conference as scheduling conflicts may occur.

Each entrant will give a prepared 4-5 minute speech on the conference theme before a panel of judges at the SASC Conference. The winning speech will be given at the Awards Ceremony. No spectators will be allowed during the judging.

To enter this contest please complete the information below, attach a TYPED copy of the speech, and bring the entry with you to the conference. All entries must be turned in at the designated area at the time of on-site registration.

Speeches must be memorized. There will be a penalty for exceeding the 4-5 minute time limit. A typewritten copy of the speech must be submitted with the entry. Judging will be based on **content, delivery, supporting material and presentation**. Only the judges will be present during the competition. **A copy of the speech evaluation form that the judges will use is posted on SASC's website.**
